



NABA'A fights against smoking during AL JANA festival

Every year during spring vacation JANA foundation organizes a series of mobile festivals all over Lebanon. NABA'A as a member of AL MAKTBAT committee, that includes 8 foundations from EIN ELHELWE and a group of Lebanese associations from Saida, participated in these festivals in KHAN ALEFRANG Saida.
